"For some NJ residents, pet care is coming closer to home. With its new 40-ft mobile veterinary unit, Rowan's Shreiber School of Veterinary Medicine (SSVM) will visit underserved neighborhoods & pet owners w/mobility issues, providing services ranging from free pet food & vaccinations to surgery... not only to "help pet owners who cannot afford traditional veterinary care but will also give Shreiber students essential hands-on experience. <u>https://svm.rowan.edu/</u> The mobile ... unit is a collaboration between SSVM & Merck Animal Health, funded by a \$500,000 gift from Merck. Equipped w/ exam space, recovery cages, & a surgical suite, the unit will supplement the small animal teaching hospital ... scheduled to open in the fall. Students working w/the mobile unit will collaborate w/ local shelters to help S/N animals, making them adoption ready. the school will not welcome its first ... 70 students til fall 2025, ...with the mobile unit's rollout planned for Nov.2025...."
